

Call for Case Studies

Urologic Nursing is currently seeking case studies to be published on a regular basis. The purpose of a case study is to describe a specific, urology-related patient situation and how the patient was managed by the urology care providers. If you are interested in submitting a case study for possible publication, please refer to the template below.

Case Study Template

Introduction:

- Description of why individual has been referred to you or was a patient under your care
- Pertinent clinical history and symptoms: include other chronic illnesses (for example, diabetes, arthritis, etc.)
- Other *relevant*, pertinent referral information

Clinical Interaction:

- Testing with summary of findings
- Prescribed care
- Attempted procedures or interventions

Results of Clinical Interaction:

- Synopsis of successful intervention
- Synopsis of failed intervention

Clinical Implications:

- Medical considerations (for example, effects of surgery, drugs)
- Nursing considerations (for example, behavioral, prescribed)
- Patient lifestyle
- Cultural issues
- Significant/other involvement
- Environmental issues (for example, individuals may be homeless)

Conclusion

- How has this experience changed or improved your practice

Total case study should be no longer than 1-3 double-spaced pages.
